All courses where there are practical activities e.g. Design and Technology, Home Economics, Science etc requires students to wear CLOSED SHOES (not open flats or sandals). IT recommendations: To successfully engage in and complete their school education, students, particularly upper school students, need access to a computer, internet, email and word processor both at school and at home. All ATAR and SIDE courses now require students to access course content on line. This content is an integral part of the student's courses. NASHS will continue to provide access to school computers and devices for students to use while at school. Increasingly some students are now bringing their own devices, BYOD, to school and using them to support their learning programs. Examples of these devices include Windows laptops, notebooks and netbooks, Apple Tablets and Android Tablets. While NASHS will support this there are certain limitations and provisos. The Department of Education provides wireless access for these devices; however the school cannot guarantee that any one device will be able to access the school network. Students with their own devices will need to complete an additional contract to the Acceptable Usage Agreement. Security of devices is the student's responsibility, and neither NASHS nor Department of Education insurance will cover their damage or loss. Bringing personal devices to NASHS is at the students own risk.
