## How to use your School Student Broadband Initiative Voucher

Support your child's online learning with a nbn internet connection at home, free until December 2025

Follow these steps to get connected:

### 1 How to get a School Student Broadband voucher

If you haven't received a voucher from a participating organisation, you can contact the National Referral Centre to see if you are eligible for a voucher

You can use the voucher if you rent or if you own your home




### To check your eligibility, or to get help using your voucher:

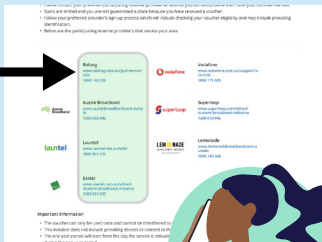

### 2 Choose and contact a participating Internet Provider

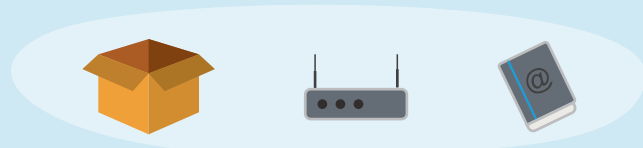
Use the contact details on the voucher  Tell the provider you would like to use your Student Broadband voucher

### 3 Get connected to the nbn® network

Your chosen Internet provider will send you a modem and instructions on how to plug it in and connect to the nbn® network



If your home has never had a nbn® broadband connection before, you may need a nbn technician appointment to install the new connection.

Your chosen internet provider will organise this appointment with you (there is no charge for a standard installation.)



If you are renting, let your landlord or property manager know before the appointment.

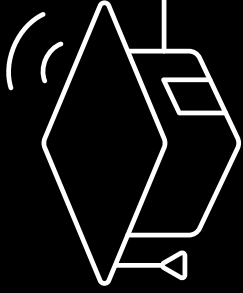
